Restaurant story sushi counter recipes

All the information that is accurate at the time of publishing. At the beginning of the three-part post, you're going to break down how to increase your profits in the game through the food you cook. This is one of these more technical entries, so please put caffeine on top before reading on! Of course, my recipe evaluation system shows which dishes are solid performers when it comes to all factors, including profits, but comparing foods for different periods is difficult and doesn't map out how to get the best bang for your buck. So let's go do it now! I start assuming you have access to 18 appliances with all the recipes and towing the game has to offer, going through level 75 (we'll get to the alternative later! and on the face of it, you might think that the dish that offers the maximum number of coins profit is a dish to cook indefinitely. It becomes peking duck (basic oven) that brings a profit of 11,900 coins per batch. Unfortunately, it's not that simple, because it's not a great use of your time, mainly because ducks are a two-day recipe. A better measure of the quality of profit is profit per hour. This allows us to actually compare foods of different lengths. In general, the main dish on this front is very short. For example, chicken salad (basic stove), chicken & dumplings (basic oven) and salmon togi (sushi counter) are one of the best benefits per hour, but they are not really suitable as they have a period of less than an hour. Fortunately, the very best benefit per hour is three hours long for biscuits and gravy (basic stove). My neighbors will be well known that this is food that is regularly cooked on my behalf, as the profit of 1,483 coins per hour is unbeatable. But there is a problem with biscuits and gravy. Unless you get less than six hours of sleep each night, biscuits and gravy are not long enough to survive overnight, so you need a recipe that allows you to do a night shift. The first possible offering may be a 9-ball cookie (basic oven). This is a 4-hour recipe that gives you a profit of 908 coins per hour and means you should be able to catch it within 8 hours of putting. Quite attached to my bed, I tend to risk narrow windows and instead choose a kiwi & cake (basic oven) with a very slightly inferior profit of 905 coins per hour. It's six hours long, so you'll be safe with it! so we're watching a round of kiwi & cake overnight with four or five batches of biscuits and gravy during the day. Repeat this process with 18 cookware and you will soon have more than enough food on the counter to avoid shortages. Does this mean that you have a magic formula? One angle we haven't explored yet is coins per plate. Most recipes in the game get 4 coins per plate, but there are some that give more or less. The number of customers you can feed in a day is fixed (if the layout is up), so you can grow each customer more. Increase your overall income. Focus on roast chicken and apple pie (both basic ovens). Roast chicken and apple pie These each offer 8 coins per the best plate around. I pick out the chicken because it gives some more portions than the pie. But still, it's not enough to keep your diner ticking: with a complete complement of appliances, a round of roast chicken gives you 27,000 plates. The design of your restaurant plays a part, but most users sell somewhere on 40,000-45,000 plates per day, so two days includes an empty counter for more than a day to wait for a second batch of chickens. So compromise is needed. The solution is very simple. Roast chicken and biscuits paired with gravy and kiwi & cake! Roast chicken, biscuits and gravy, kiwi & cake start by cooking the latter combination as outlined earlier, until you accumulate enough plates to survive a two-day batch of chicken (about 90,000 plates). When you're done, repeat the entire process. So we have: Day 1: Serve kiwi & cake and prepare roast chicken day 2: Wait for roast chicken (Day 3: You need to serve roast chicken, cook biscuits and gravy all day, kiwi & cake overnight. Before you set those chickens off, you need to make sure that the threshold for that part is exceeded. Eventually, you'll end up with a mountain of kiwis & cakes with biscuits and gravy, at which point you can skip the third day and get through it instead or do another round of roast chicken right away. Now, this strategy is fine if you can nurse the game at regular intervals throughout the day, but if that is the problem, we need an alternative. One option is to scrap the biscuits and gravy and instead tackle kiwi & cake during the day and at night. Realistically, you probably manage three batches per 24 hours, and the work between roast chicken is enough. If you can't check in during the day at all, you need a completely different attack plan. So here's another setup: 22 hours: prepare a glass-fronted ham (basic oven) for 2 hours: both glazed ham and white chocolate berries preparing two batches of white chocolate berries (romantic stoves) give five coins per piece, so in this system we always make a little more from each customer. Glazed ham and white cocoa berry drawbacks are threefold: you use the full 24 hours of the day, which means you have to get on the ball when it comes time for berry blasting. And, in part, this combination brings about 40,000 plates, so you'll be right on the edge. Therefore, poor timing can lead to empty counters. Finally, if I didn't make a Valentine's Day goal to get a romantic stove, this plan would be scooped up! Being able to cook a lot of batches of roast chicken in a row is very satisfying, especially if it spreads over many counters. This is Useful for me when I was on holiday last month - I stockpiled enough biscuits and gravy and kiwi & cake; so I could spend the whole night churning out roast chicken! The main problem for people on the ladder is the lack of appliances. Ultimately, if you're focused on making a profit, you'll have to accept disgruntled punters as you'll struggle to keep your counter stock. So I'll just outline the best benefits per plate dish as you level up. The first really noteworthy presences are apple pie and crême brûlée (basic stove). Unlocked at levels 17 and 19 respectively, they offer 8 and 5 coins per plate, so they are attractive. But of course, long waits spell trouble when you have a handful of cookware. So let's take a step back and admire the sage mushrooms (basic stove), which is the 37th best profit per hour of food in the game when you only see recipes for more than an hour. Sage mushrooms It is available from level 11, so you can be nice and quickly unstable with it. There are some dishes that will replace mushrooms on subsequent levels, such as ramen, curry (both basic stoves) and chicken alfredo (basic oven). But these are all 2-hour dishes, so if you want something longer, look at coffee (basic oven) from level 42. It lands in 11th place in the stakes of the hourly benefit of food for more than an hour and is more manageable in 5 hours. After this point, Kiwi & Cake arrives at level 51 with black pepper chicken and NY strip steak (both basic grills) also a good bet. Finally, you can get biscuits and gravy at level 71. This completes the first entry in this three-part configuration. This guide isn't exhaustive and there may be an even better strategy out there (please share!) which is simply intended as advice for how to improve your cash flow. In addition, there is the problem of designing restaurants with an efficient layout and intelligently managing counters. This post is long enough now that I don't get into those sides now! Watch out for the second installment of August when you go home with XP! I will continue to add new recipes to this table as they come out. The new recipe goes to the top.
