In 1996, it was recognized as the best shopping center in the world, and also received the International Design and Development Award. Akmerkez is a unique shopping mall because no other shopping mall in the world has both of these titles. In 2010, Akmerkez was awarded the award for best interior design by the European Commercial Property Awards.Address: Ulus Caddesi No:3, Etiler – Istanbul Park Istinye Park. © Istinye ParkLocated in the Istinye district of Saryyer district, Istinye Park brought a new dimension to Istanbul's commercial concept. Spread over an area of 242,000 m2, the shopping centre offers many outdoor and glass covered interiors such as green central park, fashion district, street shopping, 1,500 sqm children's entertainment centre, Hillside Sports and Leisure Club, - an area inspired by historical Turkish architecture - and 12 12 halls, one of which is IMAX 3D. Green, eco-friendly, humane and eye for detail is how you can best describe Istinye Park. There are three waste collection centres and a waste oil collector. Kanyon was awarded the Cityscape Architectural Review Award 2006 in the Commercial Built category. Address: Büyükdere Caddesi No:185 s City's. © Cityin case you like to be in the center of fashion, not to mention shopping, you need to see the city in Nişantaşı, part of the Şişli district and very close to Taksim. City's is a shopping center that blends into the historical structure of the area. The concept of the city is described as the Life Style Center. It certainly deserves this stylish title, given the variety of shops, cafes, restaurants and the important 24-hour six-storey car park that provides a populated area. Address: Teşvikiye Mahallesi Teşvikiye Caddesi No:162, Nişantaşı – Istanbul 𐄂antaşı Nişantaşı.This is not a shopping mall, but a district within walking distance of Taksim known for its engaged buyers in search of sophistication. In the middle of the 19th century Sultan Abdülmecid I initiated a dignified life in Nişantaşı. Today Nişantaşı has the third largest community of foreigners in Istanbul. It is a trendy shopping mall and residential area on higher scales. The inhabitants of the district are known as dignified, well-mannered and educated. Based on monthly rental prices, Abdİlpekçi is the most expensive and elegant street with outstanding Turkish brands, as well as world-famous luxury retail stores such as Christian Louboutin, Louis Vuitton, Prada, Cartier, Dior, Gucci, Gianfranco Ferré, DKNY and many others. In addition to commercial euphoria, Nişantaşı has become a well-known center of culture and art. In addition, its cafes and restaurants in the area, especially on the streets of MimKemal Öke and Atiye are juicy. Bağdat Caddesi Bağdat Caddesi.On the Asian side of the city and roughly parallel to the shores of the Marmara Sea, Bağdat Avenue is rather green and shiny 14 km long street. The first residential stairs in the area were luxury wooden residences of the cottage built after 1870. Some still exist and contribute to the rich appearance of the upper scale of the residential area. In addition to shopping, Bağdat Avenue is famous for its restaurants, pubs and service cafes of international and local cuisine. The shopping center debuted in 2009 and is built on a huge area of 495,000 square meters.
